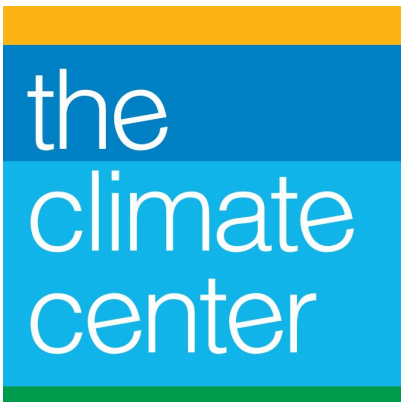

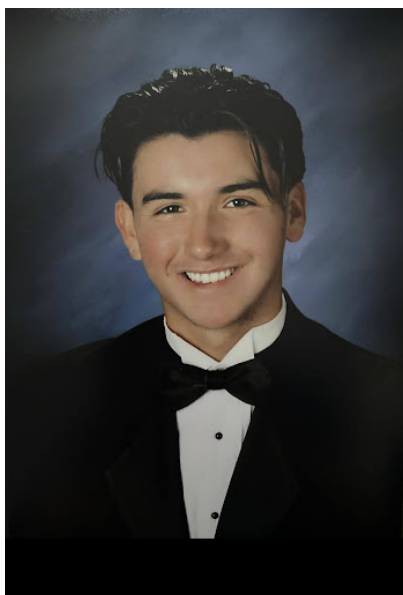
Race Around the Bay
