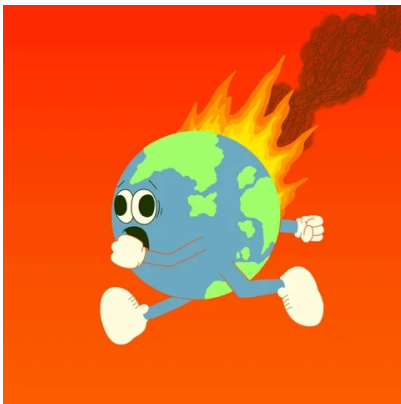

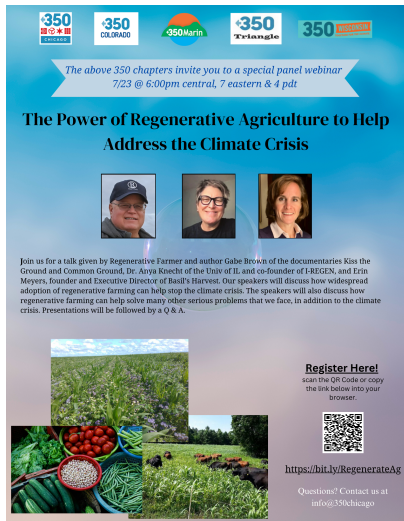

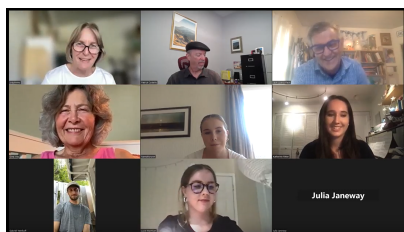


July 23 @ 4pm PDT: The Power of Regenerative Agriculture to Help Address the Climate Crisis
